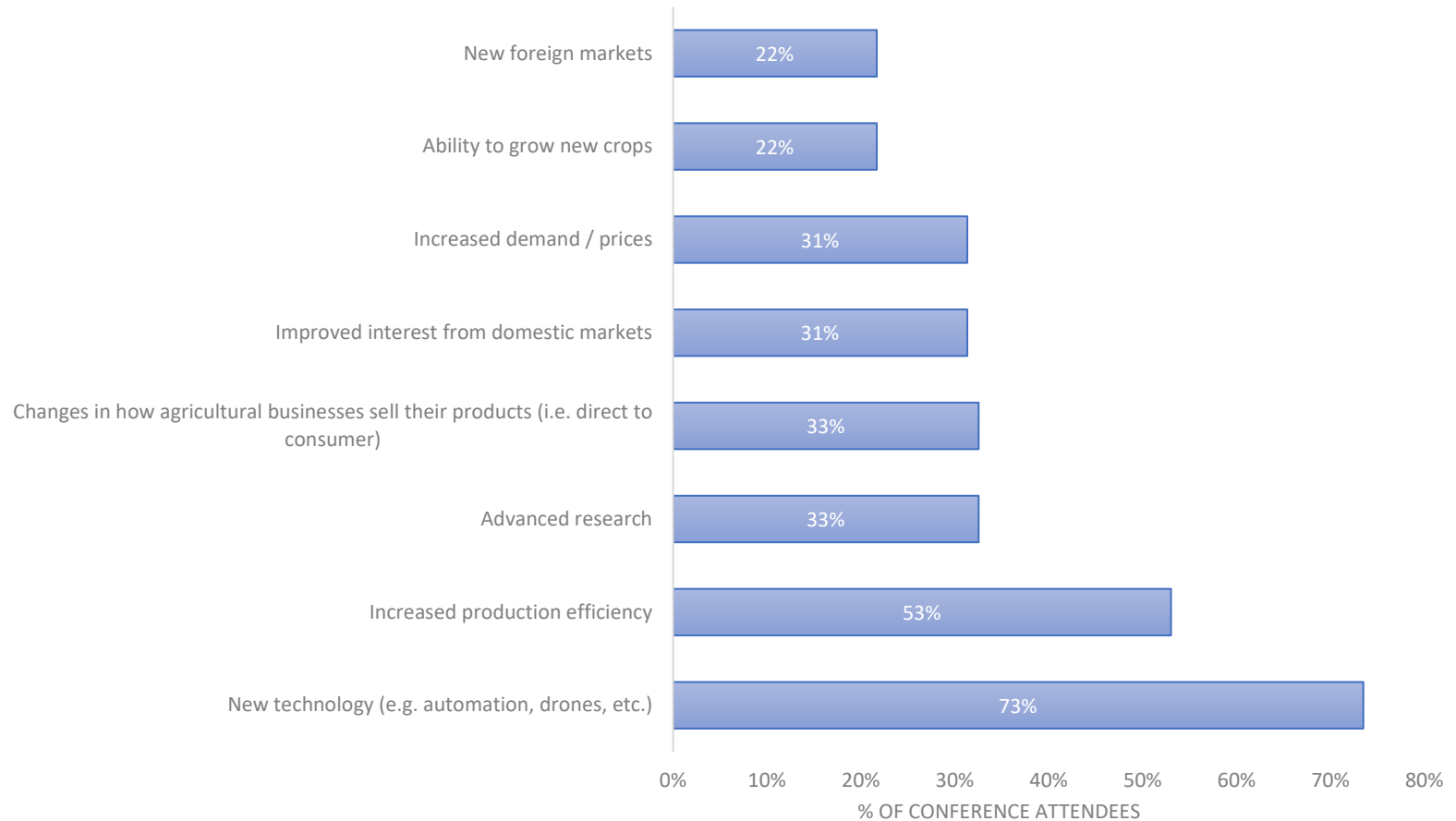

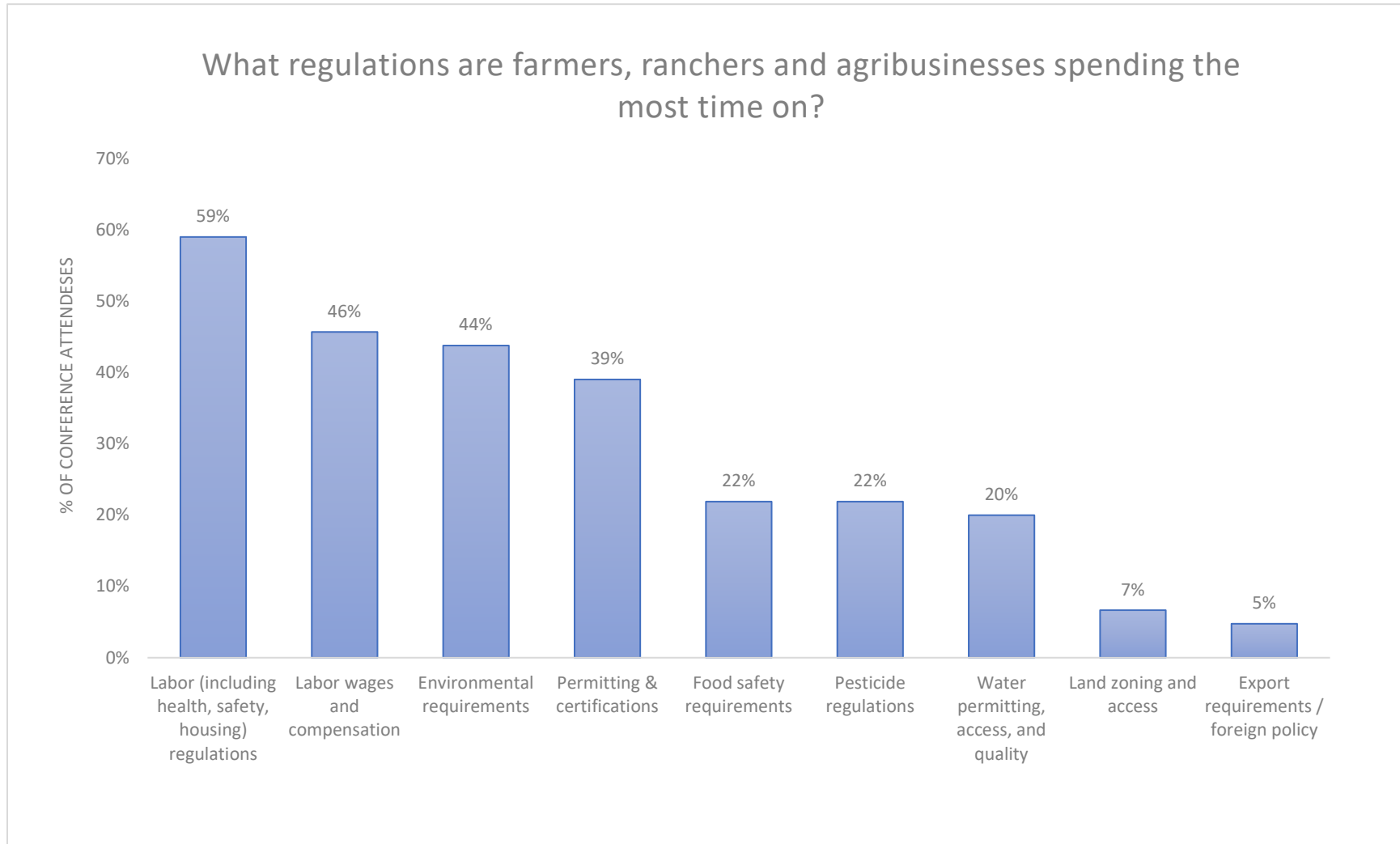

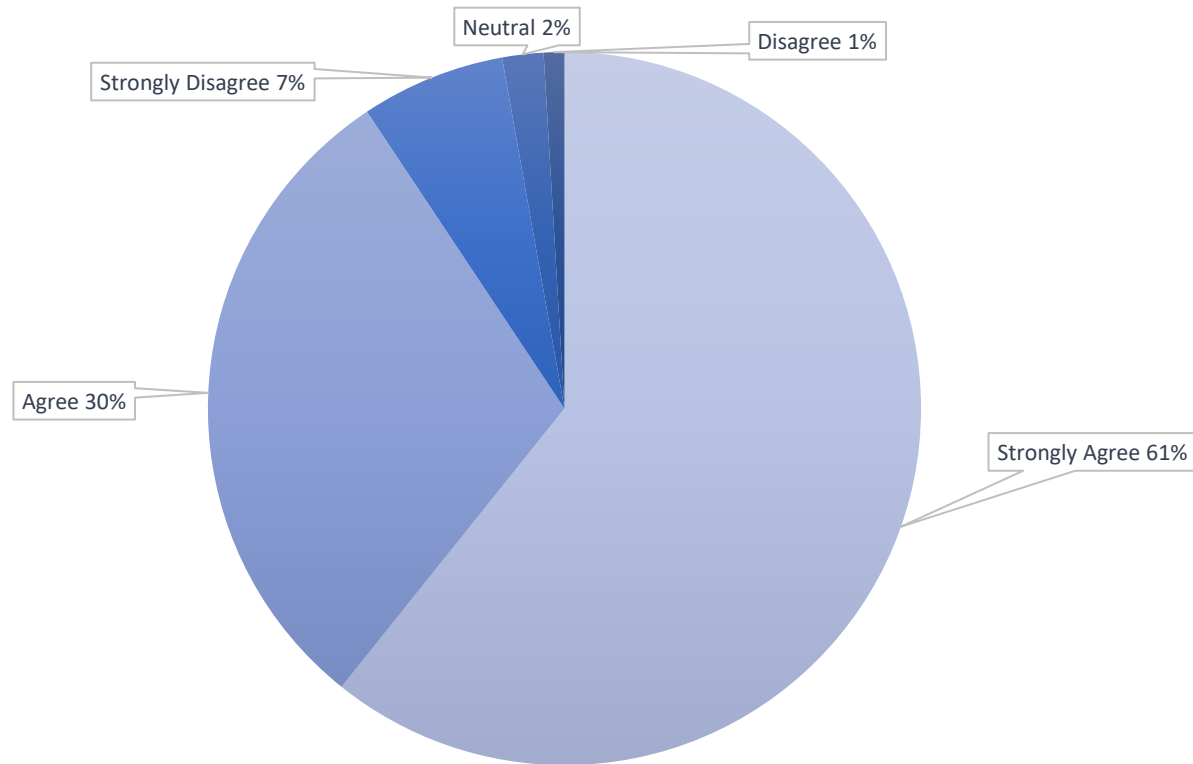
### SURVEY 1: REGULATORY & PRODUCTION COSTS

How strongly do you believe regulations are impacting Washington's agricultural businesses?

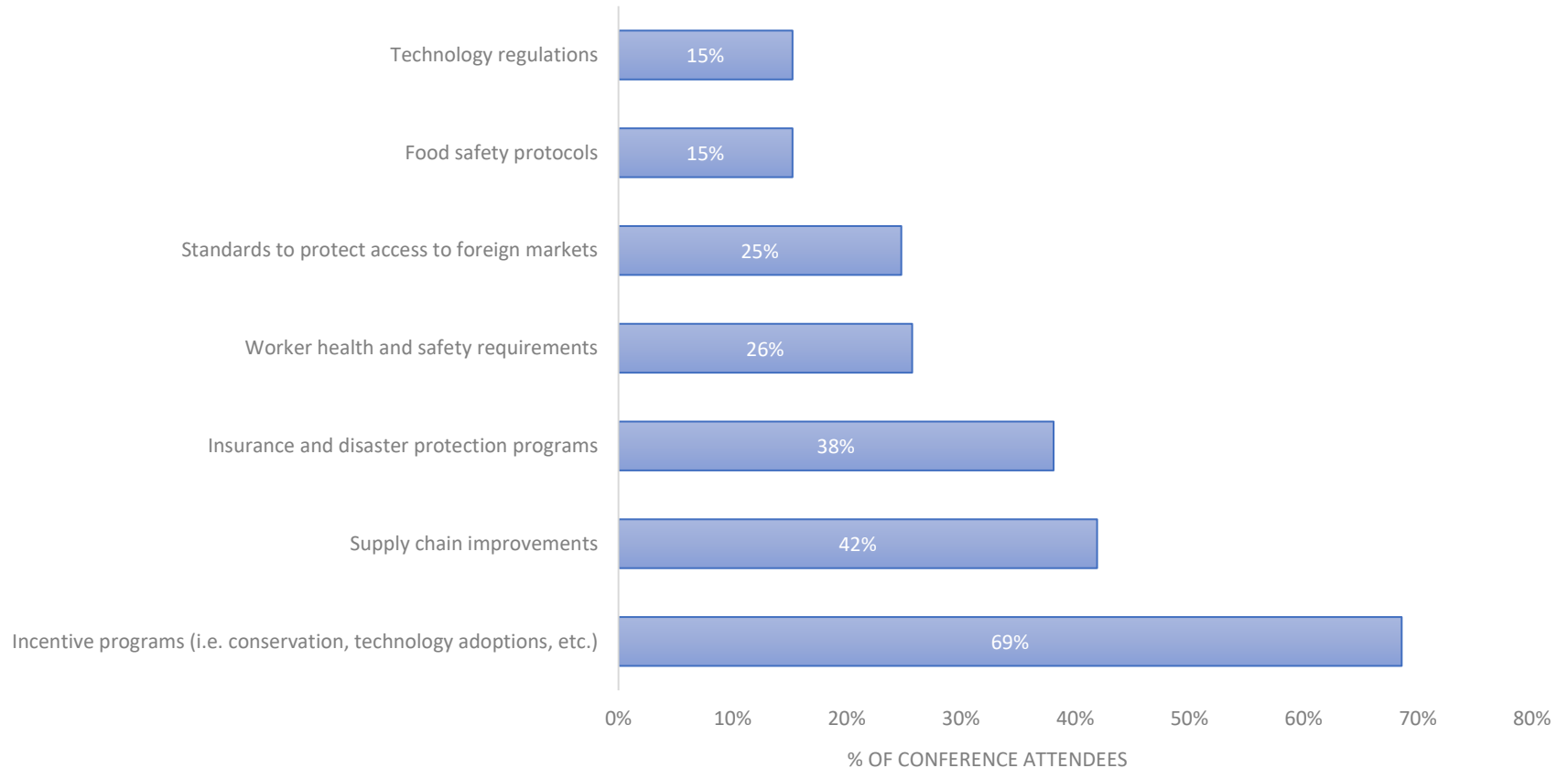

What programs or standards could be improved to enhance farm, ranch, or business production and profitability?

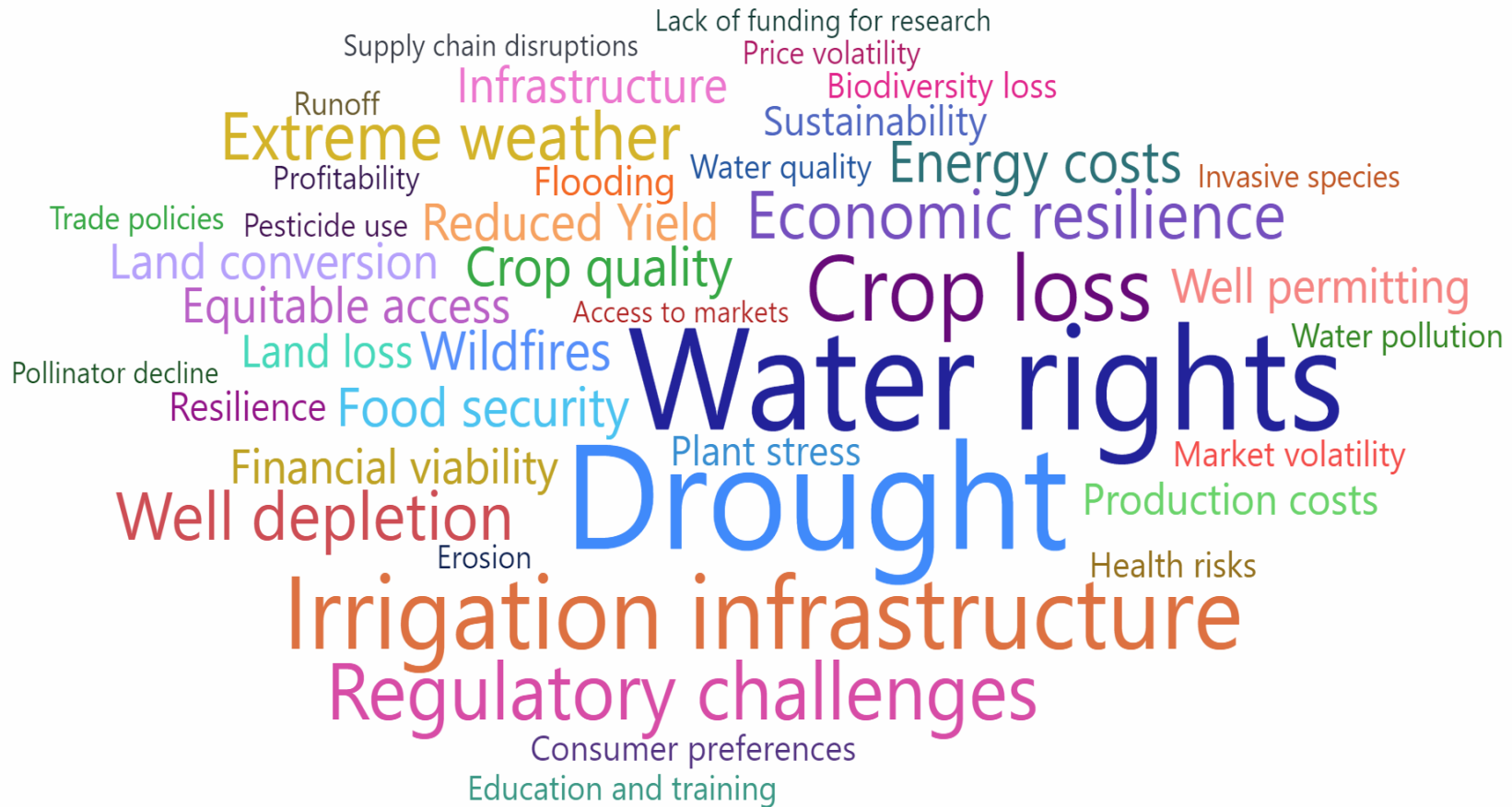

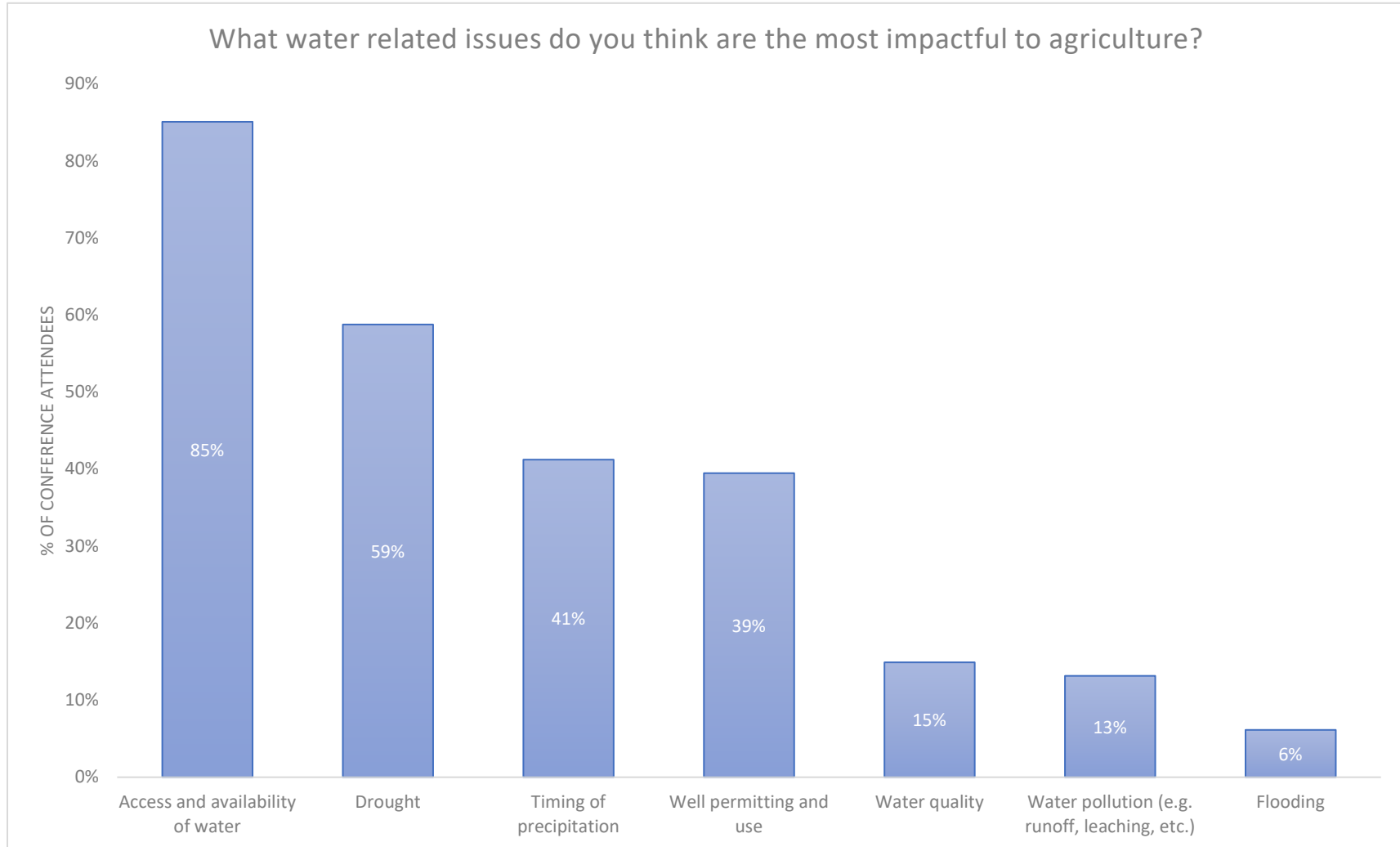
What worries you the most about water and climate in relation to agriculture in the future?

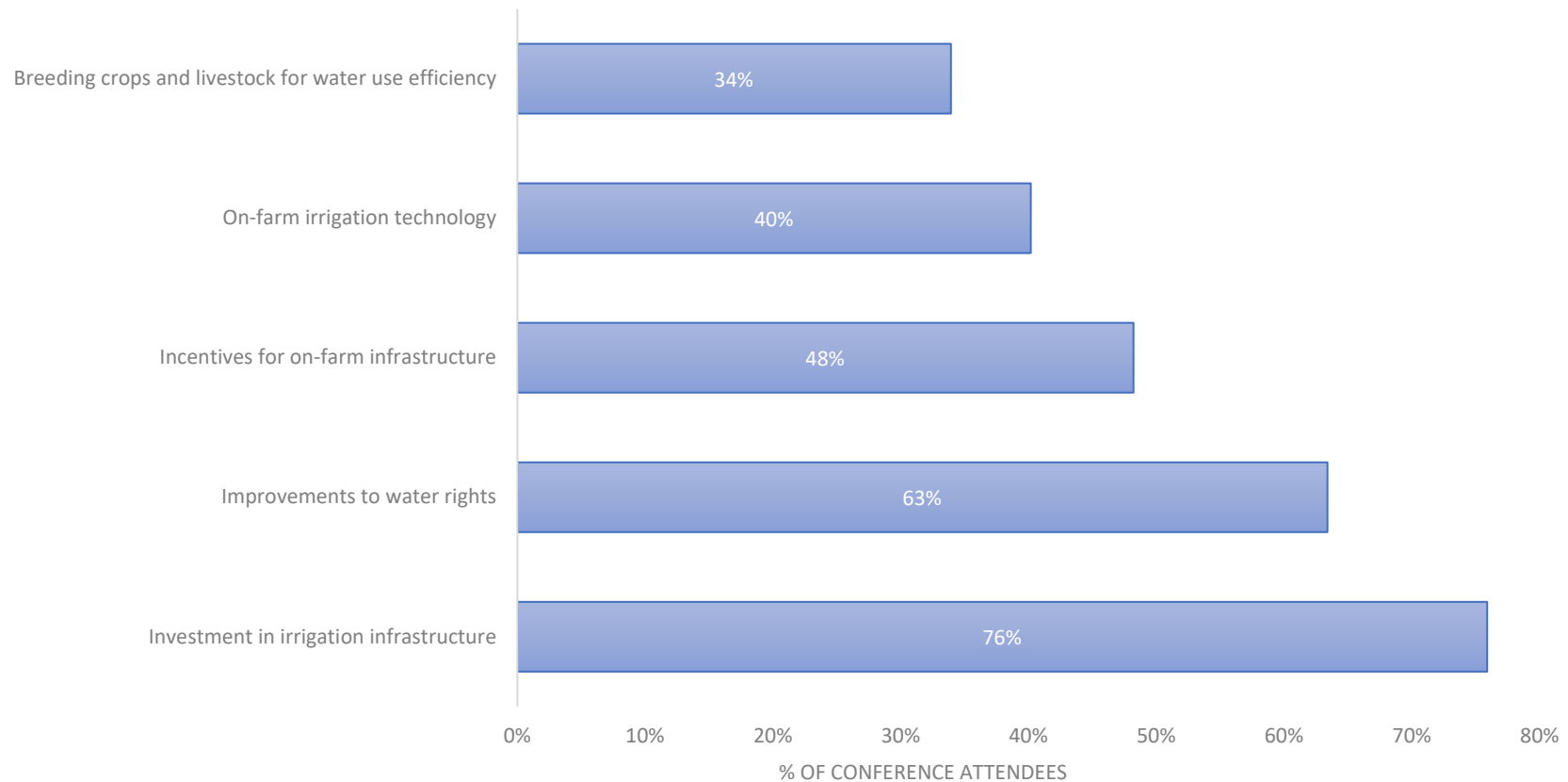

### What would be most beneficial to invest in to improve water conditions in Washington?



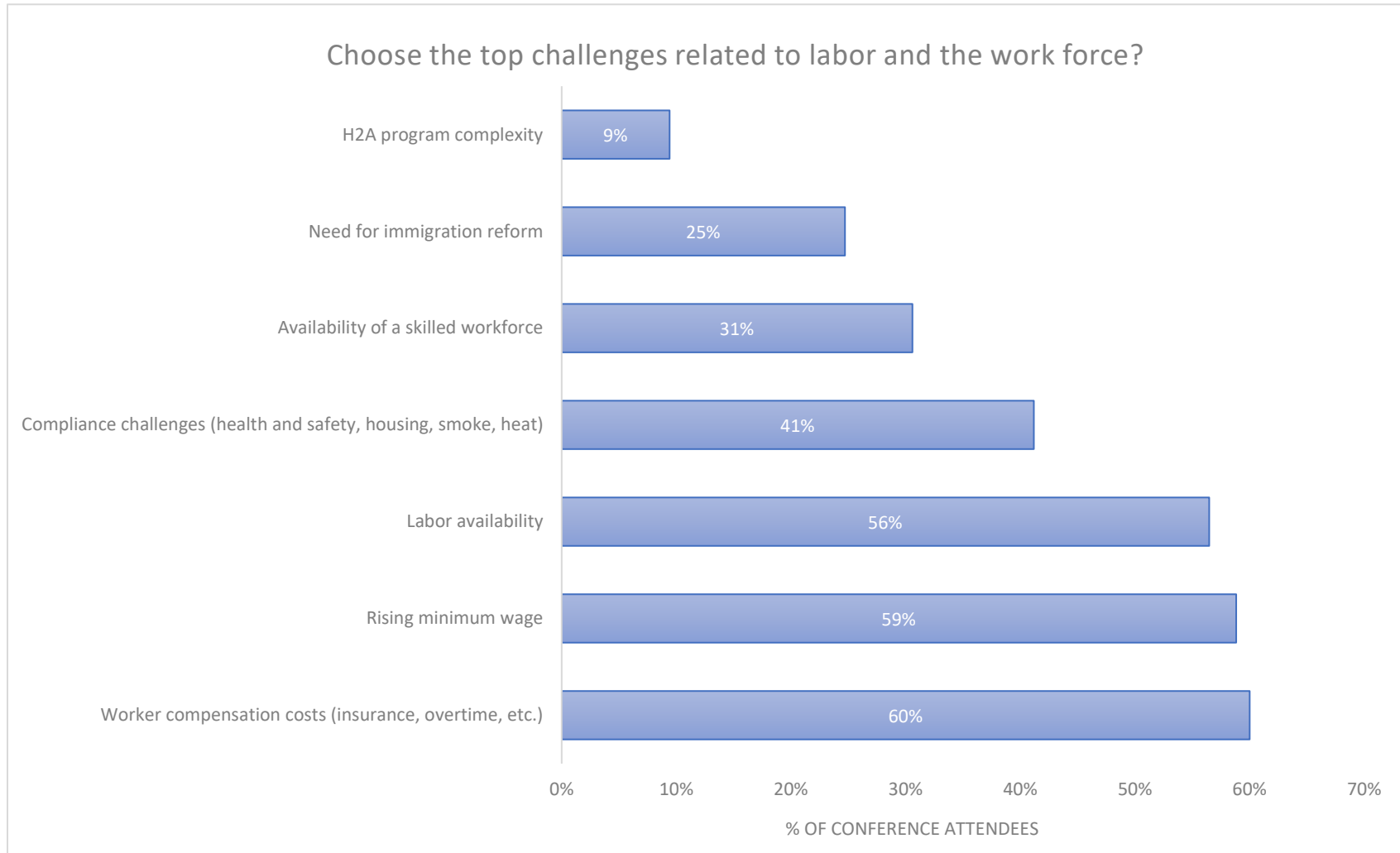

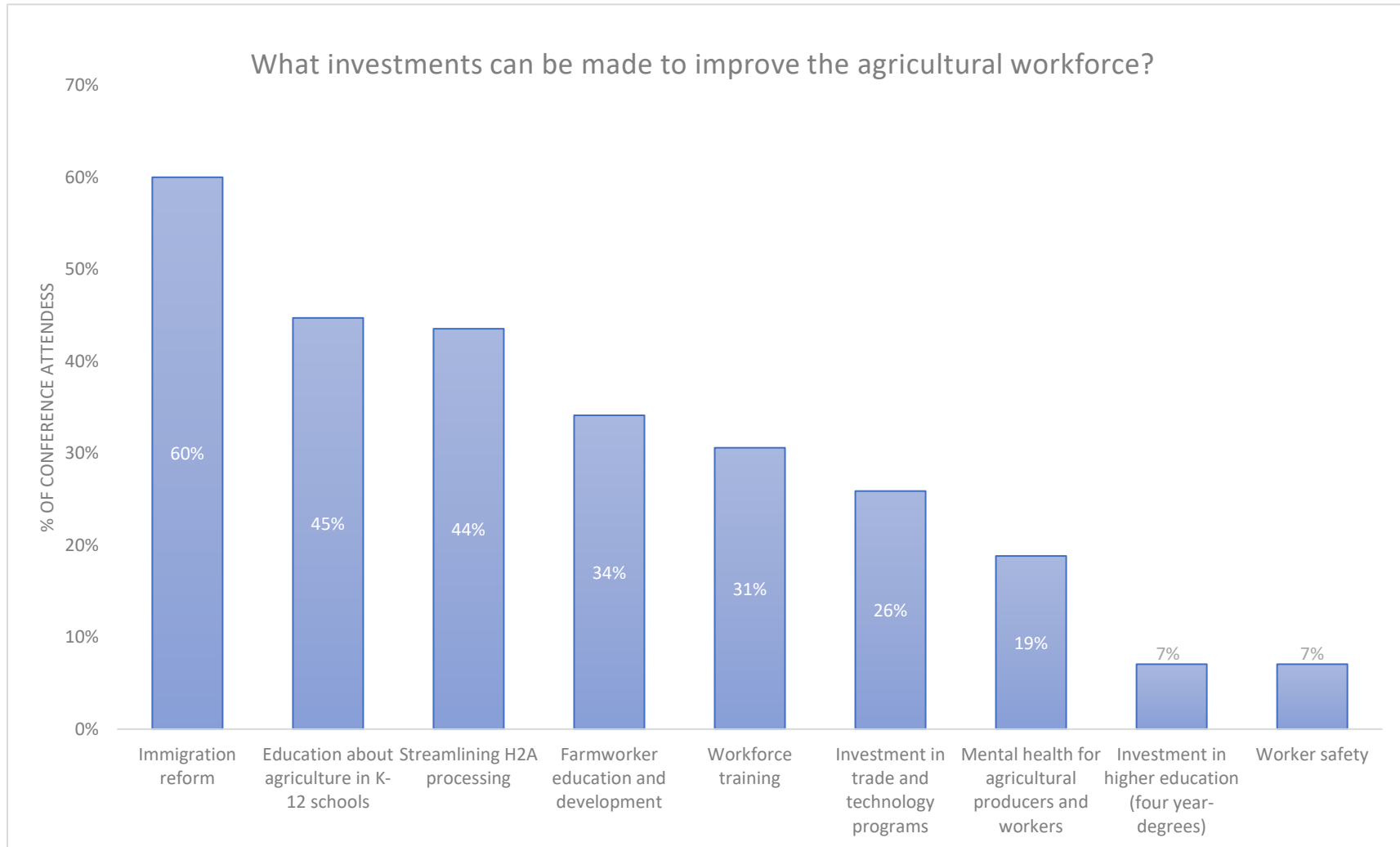
