The Inspector should annotate the form, as applicable, with any completed or promised corrections discussed during the inspection. WSDA Inspectors will only check "corrective action taken" if they are able to verify that the corrective action was taken at the time of inspection. Inclusion of annotations regarding corrective actions does not signify any conclusion by the WSDA regarding the sufficiency of the actions. If corrective action cannot be completed during the inspection, the Inspector will document an agreed-upon time frame for completion.
