SOLE SOURCE POSTING

The WSDA contemplates awarding a sole source contract to Alba's Excavating, of Grandview, WA, to provide a Grandview, WA green waste drop off site within Washington state's Japanese Beetle quarantine area.

WSDA requires an additional green waste drop off site within Washington's Japanese Beetle quarantine area, that can accept green waste throughout the 2025 growing season. The site must have a minimum 5,000 square feet concrete pad and a catch basin to prevent leachate ground water contamination. The operator must also have a front loader or similar heavy machinery to move green waste piles.

WSDA will enter into a one year contract with Alba's Excavating. The contract will be issued on or after May 28, 2025 and will continue for a one year initial term. The cost of this contract is a maximum of \$250,000.00. WSDA may opt to extend the contract for an additional three (3) times in one (1) year increments if required. WSDA determines that each optional additional one year extension would result in equal (and/or slightly higher) consideration being added to the total contract value.

Offerors contemplating the above requirements are required to submit capability statements detailing their ability to meet the state's requirements within ten (10) working days of this announcement.

Capability statements should address the following state requirements:

- Washington state green waste drop off facility with concrete pad, leachate catch basin and front loader or similar heavy equipment;
- Located in Grandview, WA within the Japanese Beetle quarantine area currently 127 square miles around Grandview/Yakima area;
- Experience handling large amounts of green waste for a large green waste collection program.
