What's Next: Reallocation & Amendment Process

- **FA Regional Reps sent your current fund balances AND the new dollar amounts**
 - Notify us ASAP if you won't be able to spend down your funding by June 30, 2020
 - Exception: EFAP COVID-19 & EFAP CARES Stabilization – Must obligate and/or spend by June 30, 2020.
 - Receipt of food, supplies, and equipment may be extended as long as it is purchased by June 30, 2020 but received no later than October 31, 2020
 - Exception: EFAP CARES Stabilization Targeted Capacity Grant - Must obligate and/or spend by June 30, 2020.
 - Capacity projects (critical & immediate) should be completed within 60 days (equipment in use by September 16, 2020)
 - Equipment versus Capital Expenditure (Building Improvements – case-by-case basis)
 - Organizations must also follow their internal purchasing rules and categorization
- **We will reallocate funding and adjust contractor allocations based on your input regarding what you can spend down/obligate by June 30, 2020**
 - This needs to be accomplished by **JUNE 12, 2020** (TODAY)
- **Amendments will be sent to you starting **JUNE 16, 2020****

Reminder:

- If you have previously unclaimed expenses then you may make adjustments to your invoices
 - Regular EFAP is retro-active to July 1, 2019 (Check with your fiscal department)
 - EFAP COVID-19 & EFAP CARES Stabilization & EFAP CARES Stabilization Targeted Capacity funds are retro-active to April 1, 2020

NEW TEFAP Income Guidelines – July 1, 2020

- **Effective July 1, 2020, TEFAP Income Eligibility Guidelines will be at 400% of the poverty rate**
 - New TEFAP Income Guidelines (PUB 445) will be available on our webpage by July 1, 2020
 - Translations: Spanish, Russian, Ukrainian, Vietnamese, Somali, Korean, and Chinese (simplified) – may not be ready by July 1, 2020.
 - TEFAP Client Intake Forms will be updated and on our webpage by July 1, 2020
 - TEFAP Client Intake Form (AGR-2271)
 - TEFAP Individual Client Intake Form (AGR-2342)
 - TEFAP Minimum Requirements (PUB 721)
 - TEFAP Client Notification (PUB 768) - handout and poster size
 - Includes minimum requirements language, income guidelines, and the full USDA Nondiscrimination Statement
- **TEFAP Procedures Manual has not been updated**
