Amendment Approval. Please note that your amendment is not guaranteed or granted until you receive approvals from both the Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA) and the Washington State Liquor and Cannabis Board (WSLCB).

Approval Timeline. Please note that the processing time from the receipt of your amendment request to the time of determination by WSDA could take 6-8 weeks. The WSLCB will also need to review your request. It may take longer if you do not complete and attach all the documentation required.

Changes to Location or Ownership. Please contact both WSDA and WSLCB to discuss the approval process for changes in location or ownership prior to making these changes.

Product Amendment: Addition or Change Request

Please submit the product name and ingredient statement for each proposed Cannabis-Infused Edible (CIE) product. For the **Product Name**, list full product name, including the specific name you have given your product, along with the common name of the product. The proposed label information may not be used until approved.

For the **Ingredient Statement**, WSDA will work with you on the product labeling requirements. If attaching separately, please include the information in an electronic format that can be copied and pasted.

NOTE: Full CIE product packaging and labeling requirements will be reviewed by the Washington State Liquor and Cannabis Board (WSLCB). The WSLCB will work with you to meet these additional requirements (see <u>WAC 314-55-105</u> and WAC 314-55-077).

Ingredient statements will include:

Full Name of Product. List full product name. Example, for Chocolate Peanut Butter Walnut Brownie, include the specific name you have given your product (Chocolate Peanut Butter Walnut), along with the common name of the product (Brownie).

Ingredients. All ingredients must be listed in descending order by weight.

Allergens. Ingredient list must properly disclose major allergens: Wheat, Peanuts, Eggs, Milk, Soy, Fish, Crustacean Shellfish (such as crab, shrimp, lobster), Sesame Seeds, and Tree Nuts (such as almonds, pecans, walnuts). Also include sensitivity agents FD&C Yellow 5, and sulfites when they are at a level that requires disclosure.

The following sample ingredient statement illustrates the ingredient and allergen labeling requirements:

Chocolate Peanut Butter Walnut Brownie

Ingredients: Brown Sugar (Sugar, Invert Sugar, Cane Molasses), All-Purpose Flour (Wheat Flour, Niacin, Reduced Iron, Thiamine mononitrate, Riboflavin, Folic acid), Milk Chocolate (Sugar, Whole Milk Powder, Cocoa Butter, Cocoa Mass, Soy Lecithin, Vanilla), Peanut Butter (Peanuts, Sugar, Molasses, Hydrogenated Vegetable Oil, Monoand diglycerides, Salt), Chopped Walnuts, Dextrose, Salt, Artificial Flavoring, Leavening (Sodium bicarbonate), Cannabis Extract.

Contains: Milk, Peanuts, Soy, Walnuts, Wheat
