

NPDES WAG993000 requires that the Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA) submit an annual freshwater emergent weed monitoring plan to the Washington State Department of Ecology (WSDOE) and conduct monitoring as necessary.

WSDA proposed to monitor bispyribac-sodium, carfentrazone-ethyl, flumioxazin or penoxsulam treatments if these active ingredients were used under the permit in 2019. No applications of these ingredients occurred under the permit in 2019.
