

DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal 2024 Japanese Beetle Eradication. The Washington State Department of Agriculture is
proposing to issue a Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) for the eradication of Japanese beetle
(Popillia japonica) on approximately 180 acres in an area of Franklin County, Washington. Proposed
<u>turfgrass</u> foliar applications will be completed using either the insecticide chlorantraniliprole or the biological
insecticide Bacillus thuringiensis subs. galleriae on approximately 1,063 residential, commercial, and
industrial properties.

Franklin county during the spring, summer, and fall of 2024. The proposed location of treatments is south of
the Tri-Cities Airport and west of State Route 395 in West Pasco. Township 09 North, Range 29 East,
