## DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal 2023 Japanese Beetle Eradication. The Washington State Department of Agriculture is proposing to issue a Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) for the eradication of Japanese beetle (*Popillia japonica*) on approximately 2,100 acres in a 74 square mile area encompassing Grandview, Mabton, Wapato and surrounding areas of Yakima and Benton counties, Washington. Proposed turfgrass foliar applications will be completed using either the insecticide chlorantraniliprole or the biological insecticide *Bacillus thuringiensis subs. galleriae* on approximately 7,400 residential, commercial, and industrial properties.

Proponent Washington State Department of Agriculture

Location of proposal, including street address, if any This project SEPA covers the proposed treatment in Yakima and Benton counties during the spring, summer, and fall of 2023.

Lead agency Washington State Department of Agriculture

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment.
