

## DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal 2023 Japanese Beetle Eradication. The Washington State Department of Agriculture is
proposing to issue a Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) for the eradication of Japanese beetle
(Popillia japonica) on approximately 2,100 acres in a 74 square mile area encompassing Grandview, Mabton,
Wapato and surrounding areas of Yakima and Benton counties, Washington. Proposed turfgrass foliar
applications will be completed using either the insecticide chlorantraniliprole or the biological insecticide
Bacillus thuringiensis subs. galleriae on approximately 7,400 residential, commercial, and industrial
properties
