### WSDA Resources:

**TEFAP:** The Emergency Food Assistance Program and the Trade Mitigation Program, provide federal USDA food and limited operational funding to emergency food providers.

and 0 TEFAP meal programs.*

Allocated Operational Funding: \$27,244  
Estimated Pounds of Food: 230,366  
Estimated Value of Food: \$202,460

**CSFP:** The federal Commodity Supplemental Food Program provides a prescribed quantity of USDA food to low income persons at least 60 years of age.

Average Monthly Clients: 89


**EFAP:** The state Emergency Food Assistance Program provides state funding to help pay for administrative, operational and food costs of emergency food providers.

Allocated Funding: \$29,452


**2** emergency food providers
