### WSDA Resources:

**TEFAP:** The Emergency Food Assistance Program and the Trade Mitigation Program, provide federal USDA food and limited operational funding to emergency food providers.

**Community Services of Moses Lake**  
supporting 6 TEFAP food pantries  
and 0 TEFAP meal programs.

Allocated Operational Funding: \$71,566  
Estimated Pounds of Food: 605,139  
Estimated Value of Food: \$531,836  
Average Monthly Clients: 6,935  
Average Monthly Households: 2,693

**CSFP:** The federal Commodity Supplemental Food Program provides a prescribed quantity of USDA food to low income persons at least 60 years of age.

Average Monthly Clients: 492


**EFAP:** The state Emergency Food Assistance Program provides state funding to help pay for administrative, operational and food costs of emergency food providers.

supporting 8 EFAP food pantries.


Allocated Funding: \$88,812
