### WSDA Resources:

**TEFAP:** The Emergency Food Assistance Program provides federal USDA food and limited operational funding to emergency food providers.

**Community Services of Moses Lake**  
Supporting 6 TEFAP food pantries/sites  
and 0 TEFAP meal programs.

Allocated Operational Funding: \$ 46,036.13  
Estimated Pounds of Food: 250,057.01  
Estimated Value of Food: \$ 219,785.63  
Average Monthly Clients: 7,141  
Average Monthly Households: 2,669

**CSFP:** The federal Commodity Supplemental Food Program provides a prescribed quantity of USDA food to low-income persons at least 60 years of age.

Supporting 5 CSFP sponsored sites.

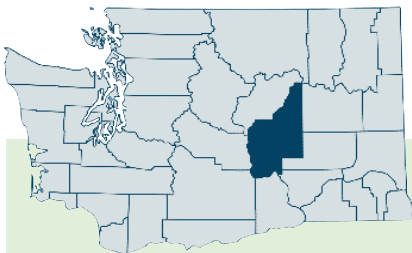

Allocated Funding: \$ 89,011.82

compared to the state average of 17.9 lbs.

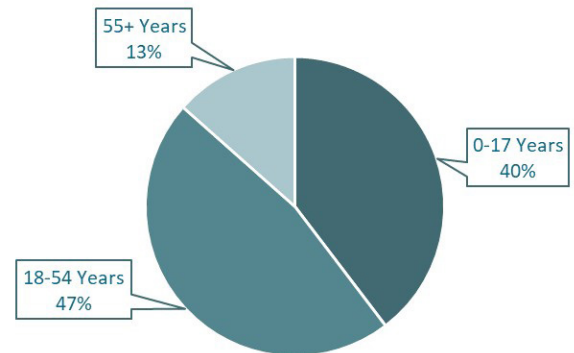
