### WSDA Resources:

**TEFAP:** The Emergency Food Assistance Program provides federal USDA food and limited operational funding to emergency food providers.

**Coastal Community Action Program**  
Supporting 12 TEFAP food pantries and 2 TEFAP meal programs.

Allocated Operational Funding: \$ 25,116.22  
Estimated Pounds of Food: 249,554.46  
Estimated Value of Food: \$ 163,153.86  
Average Monthly Clients: 9,548  
Average Monthly Households: 3,601

**CSFP:** The federal Commodity Supplemental Food Program provides a prescribed quantity of USDA food to low income persons at least 60 years of age.

**Coastal Community Action Program**  
Supporting 3 CSFP sponsored sites.

Estimated Pounds of Food: 43,647.57  
Estimated Value of Food: \$ 31,271.09  
Average Monthly Clients: 130

**EFAP:** The state Emergency Food Assistance Program provides state funding to help pay for administrative, operational and food costs of emergency food providers.

**Coastal Harvest**  
Supporting 9 EFAP food pantries.

Allocated Funding: \$ 75,623.43

compared to the state average of 17.5 lbs.


