WSDA Resources:

TEFAP: The Emergency Food Assistance Program and the Trade Mitigation Program, provide federal USDA food and limited operational funding to emergency food providers.

Coastal Community Action Program
*supporting 13 TEFAP food pantries
and 2 TEFAP meal programs.*

Allocated Operational Funding: \$56,927
Estimated Pounds of Food: 481,361
Estimated Value of Food: \$423,052

CSFP: The federal Commodity Supplemental Food Program provides a prescribed quantity of USDA food to low income persons at least 60 years of age.

Average Monthly Clients: 204

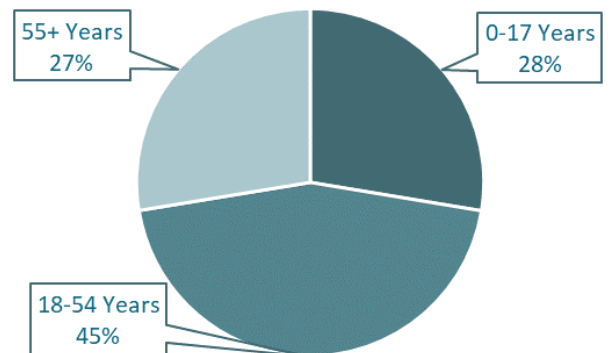
EFAP: The state Emergency Food Assistance Program provides state funding to help pay for administrative, operational and food costs of emergency food providers.

Allocated Funding: \$70,777

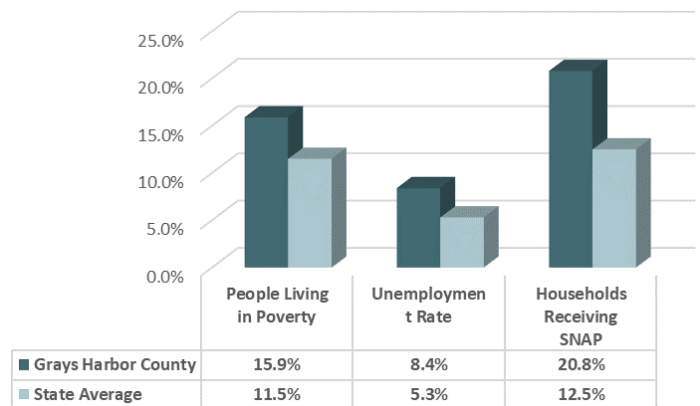
15 emergency food providers

2019 EFAP Clients by Age Group

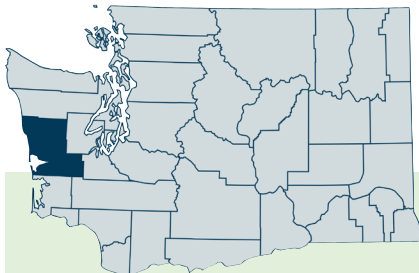


10,218 households served; **2.5** clients per household;
