## WSDA Resources:

**TEFAP:** The Emergency Food Assistance Program and the Trade Mitigation Program, provide federal USDA food and limited operational funding to emergency

food providers.

**Coastal Community Action Program** supporting 13 TEFAP food pantries and 2 TEFAP meal programs.

Allocated Operational Funding: \$56,927 Estimated Pounds of Food: 481,361 Estimated Value of Food: \$423,052 Average Monthly Clients: 5,346 Average Monthly Households: 2,226

**CSFP:** The federal Commodity Supplemental Food Program provides a prescribed quantity of USDA food to low income persons at least 60 years of age.

**Coastal Community Action Program** *supporting 4 CSFP sponsored sites.*

**EFAP:** The state Emergency Food Assistance Program provides state funding to help pay for administrative,

operational and food costs of emergency

food providers.


Coastal Harvest supporting 9 EFAP food pantries.

**12.4 lbs.** of food per EFAP client visit compared to the state average of 18.9 lbs.


**15** emergency food providers are directly supported with WSDA resources.
