WSDA Resources:

TEFAP: The Emergency Food Assistance Program provides federal USDA food and limited operational funding

to emergency food providers.

Community Action of Skagit County Supporting 1 TEFAP food pantry and 0 TEFAP meal programs.

Allocated Operational Funding: \$ 17,971.38 Estimated Pounds of Food: 131,599.94 Estimated Value of Food: \$ 86,037.48 Average Monthly Clients: 6,339 Average Monthly Households: 2,067

CSFP: The federal Commodity Supplemental Food Program provides a prescribed quantity of USDA food to low income persons at least 60 years of age.

EFAP: The state Emergency Food Assistance Program provides state funding to help pay for administrative, operational and food costs of emergency food providers.


North Whidbey Help House Supporting 2 EFAP food pantries.

21.6 lbs. of food per client visit compared to the state average of 17.5 lbs.


2 emergency feeding organizations are directly supported with WSDA resources.
