## **WSDA Resources:**

**TEFAP:** The Emergency Food Assistance Program provides federal USDA food and limited operational funding

to emergency food providers.

Olympic Community Action Program Supporting 5 TEFAP food pantries and 1 TEFAP meal program.

Allocated Operational Funding: \$ 14,459.16 Estimated Pounds of Food: 73,616.46 Estimated Value of Food: \$ 48,129.01

Average Monthly Clients: 766 Average Monthly Households: 306

**CSFP:** The federal Commodity Supplemental Food Program provides a prescribed quantity of USDA food to low income persons at least 60 years of age.

Average Monthly Clients: 125

**EFAP:** The state Emergency Food Assistance Program provides state funding to help pay for administrative, operational and food costs of emergency food providers.


Olympic Community Action Program Supporting 4 EFAP food pantries.

**15.6 lbs.** of food per client visit compared to the state average of 17.5 lbs.


**6** emergency feeding organizations are directly supported with WSDA resources.
