### WSDA Resources:

**TEFAP:** The Emergency Food Assistance Program and the Trade Mitigation Program, provide federal USDA food and limited operational funding to emergency food providers.

and 0 TEFAP meal programs.

Allocated Operational Funding: \$21,958  
Estimated Pounds of Food: 185,668  
Estimated Value of Food: \$163,177

**CSFP:** The federal Commodity Supplemental Food Program provides a prescribed quantity of USDA food to low income persons at least 60 years of age.

Average Monthly Clients: 225


**EFAP:** The state Emergency Food Assistance Program provides state funding to help pay for administrative, operational and food costs of emergency food providers.

Allocated Funding: \$25,089


**3** emergency food providers

### 2019 EFAP Clients by Age Group




**1,340** households served; **2.4** clients per household;
