WSDA Resources:

TEFAP: The Emergency Food Assistance Program and the Trade Mitigation Program, provide federal USDA food and limited operational funding to emergency food providers.

supporting 9 TEFAP food pantries and 4 TEFAP meal programs.

Allocated Operational Funding: \$60,180
Estimated Pounds of Food: 508,867
Estimated Value of Food: \$447,226

CSFP: The federal Commodity Supplemental Food Program provides a prescribed quantity of USDA food to low income persons at least 60 years of age.

EFAP: The state Emergency Food Assistance Program provides state funding to help pay for administrative, operational and food costs of emergency food providers.




19 emergency food providers are directly supported with WSDA resources.
