
**EFAP:** The state Emergency Food Assistance Program provides state funding to help pay for administrative, operational and food costs of emergency food providers.



**64,062** households served; **3.2** clients per household; **6.5** visits per year, per EFAP client.


**22,593,461 lbs.** of food distributed in **1,236,240** total EFAP client visits.
