## **WSDA Resources:**

**TEFAP:** The Emergency Food Assistance Program provides federal USDA food and limited operational funding

to emergency food providers.

**Volunteers of America Western Washington** Supporting 19 TEFAP food pantries and 19 TEFAP meal programs.

Allocated Operational Funding: \$ 95,668.60 Estimated Pounds of Food: 1,414,307.56 Estimated Value of Food: \$ 924,646.80 Average Monthly Clients: 30,065 Average Monthly Households: 10,481

**CSFP:** The federal Commodity Supplemental Food Program provides a prescribed quantity of USDA food to low income persons at least 60 years of age.

Volunteers of America Western Washington Supporting 13 CSFP sponsored sites.

Allocated Operational Funding: \$46,154.47 Estimated Pounds of Food: 221,595.38 Estimated Value of Food: \$158,760.94

Average Monthly Clients: 660

**EFAP:** The state Emergency Food Assistance Program provides state funding to help pay for administrative, operational and food costs of emergency food providers.



**28.5 lbs.** of food per client visit compared to the state average of 17.5 lbs.


**38** emergency feeding organizations are directly supported with WSDA resources.
