The mission of Volunteers of America Western Washington is “to serve people and communities in need and create opportunities for people to experience the joy of serving others.” 2019 was their fifth year in a lead role with the Farm to Food Pantry initiative.



In 2018, the lead agency in the 21st Legislative District:

- Received a total of \$2,250 in state funds to purchase produce from local farmers.
- Matched government investment with \$500 in community funds, increasing their F2FP purchasing power.
- Purchased 2,750 pounds of produce from local farmers.
- Received an additional 14,000 pounds of donated or gleaned produce from local farmers.
