Hopelink - Kirkland

Hopelink Harvest is the hub of Hopelink’s efforts to increase access to healthy food. Through partnerships with local farms, farmers markets, community gardens, and individual growers, the Hopelink Harvest program collects donations of surplus produce for distribution at Hopelink food banks. Together, they are growing a healthier community for everyone! 2019 was their fourth year with Farm to Food Pantry.

In 2018, the lead agency in the 48th Legislative District:

- Received a total of **\$2,250** in state funds to purchase produce from local farmers.
- **Matched government investment with \$2,613** in community funds, more than doubling their F2FP purchasing power.
- **Purchased 2,682 pounds** of produce from local farmers.
- Received an **additional 5,803 pounds** of donated or gleaned produce from local farmers.
