Clark County Food Bank - Vancouver



The mission of Clark County Food Bank (CCFB) is: To alleviate hunger and its root causes. Achieving their mission is done in two parts: providing emergency food relief to individuals and families, as well as implementing a preventative stance against the various causes of hunger.

In 2018, one lead agency in the 49th Legislative District:

- Received \$2,250 in state funds to purchase produce from local farmers.
- Matched government investment with \$500 in community funds to enhance their F2FP purchasing power.
- Purchased 3,167 pounds of produce from local farmers.
- Received an additional 6,583 pounds of donated or gleaned produce from local farmers.
