N.E.W. Hunger Coalition - Colville

The N.E.W. Hunger Coalition serves as a collaborative forum for all the individuals and groups working to meet the hunger relief demands of Stevens County. The Coalition is comprised of 15 independent food pantries.



Okanogan County Community Action Council - Okanogan

Okanogan County Community Action Council (OCCAC) is a cornerstone of the community effort to end poverty through education and employment.



In 2018, two lead agencies in the 7th Legislative District:

- Received a combined total of **\$4,500** in state funds to purchase produce from local farmers.
- **Matched government investment with \$7,600** in community funds, more than doubling their F2FP purchasing power.
- **Purchased 15,794 pounds** of produce from local farmers.
- Received an **additional 26,626 pounds** of donated or gleaned produce from local farmers.
