### WSDA Resources:

**TEFAP:** The Emergency Food Assistance Program provides federal USDA food and limited operational funding to emergency food providers.

**Community Services of Moses Lake**  
Supporting 2 TEFAP food pantries/sites and 0 TEFAP meal programs.

Allocated Operational Funding: \$ 10,623.72  
Estimated Pounds of Food: 61,716.58  
Estimated Value of Food: \$ 54,245.30

**CSFP:** The federal Commodity Supplemental Food Program provides a prescribed quantity of USDA food to low-income persons at least 60 years of age.

Allocated Funding: \$ 29,500.91

compared to the state average of 17.9 lbs.


