### WSDA Resources:

**TEFAP:** The Emergency Food Assistance Program provides federal USDA food and limited operational funding to emergency food providers.

**Community Action Council of Lewis, Mason, & Thurston Counties**

Supporting 7 TEFAP food pantries/sites and 5 TEFAP meal programs.

Allocated Operational Funding: \$ 50,602.35  
Estimated Pounds of Food: 413,051.69  
Estimated Value of Food: \$ 363,048.51  
Average Monthly Clients: 7,620  
Average Monthly Households: 2,582

**CSFP:** The federal Commodity Supplemental Food Program provides a prescribed quantity of USDA food to low-income persons at least 60 years of age.

Supporting 20 CSFP sponsored sites.

Estimated Pounds of Food: 215,297.84  
Estimated Value of Food: \$ 159,446.25  
Average Monthly Clients: 639

**EFAP:** The state Emergency Food Assistance Program provides state funding to help pay for administrative, operational and food costs of emergency food providers.

**St. Vincent de Paul - Bremerton**

Supporting 8 EFAP food pantries.

Allocated Funding: \$ 140,514.11

**18.0 lbs.** of food per client visit compared to the state average of 17.9 lbs.


